*Subject:* USDA Rates of Reimbursement Effective July 1, 2015

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has adjusted the reimbursement rate for the Special Milk Program from \$0.2025 per half pint to \$0.2000 per half pint. The annual rate adjustment for the Special Milk Program reflects changes in the Producer Price Index for Fluid Milk Products. **The new reimbursement rate of \$0.2000 per half pint was effective July 1, 2015, and will therefore be applied to your July 2015 reimbursement claim.**
