Goal

The goal of the CTSO Collaborative Project is to improve teen traffic safety in Wisconsin through student-directed projects that focus on at least one of these areas: 1) Distracted Driving 2) Seat Belt Use 3) Speeding 4) Impaired Driving 5) Peer Passengers.

Proposals

To be considered for a 2016-17 Collaborative Project, please submit a proposal using this link: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/BSSLWZK>. Proposals will be accepted throughout the 2016-17 school year.

Schools will be notified if their proposal is accepted 2-3 weeks after submission. Upon acceptance, schools will be asked to complete a project plan and budget with the help of Crossroads Teen Driving experts. Projects may be combined with other grants and competitive activities to maximize the impact.

Funding

Funding will be offered based on the strength of the proposal, and awarded at the completion of activities to reimburse expenses. Funding from other sources such as community donations may be combined with these funds to enhance the project.
