Superintendent Evers' statement on Assembly passage of SB 67

MADISON — State Superintendent Tony Evers issued a statement related to the Wisconsin State Assembly approving Senate Bill 67.

“Given the concern about how test results are applied, particularly with the ongoing dialogue of changing assessments, pausing use of the current year’s results is appropriate. I would like to thank the legislators that drafted and ushered this proposal, which we supported and helped shape, through the process, especially Senator Farrow and Representative Kitchens. I look forward to the governor signing SB 67 into law.”
